Member Data

- email address (optional)
- Mobile number (optional)

What we do with the information:

- provide information to you (e.g. about proposed trips),
- make contact with you, (e.g. changes to planned rides).

Security

We are committed to ensuring that your information is secure. We have put in place physical, electronic and administrative procedures to safeguard and secure the information we collect. These include for example, limiting access to the data.
